- V. Library Roof Project

In order to make sure the Library does not deplete their reserve and building repair lines I am recommending Council allow us to take the payment from the following lines; Library Building and Repairs #E-01-02-40-35 \$6,000.00, Library Reserves #E-01-02-30-40 \$5,000.00, Administration Reserves #E-01-02-30-40 \$14,750.00.

Recommendation: Town Council approves the payment of the Town of Fort Fairfield Library Project be taken from the Library Building Repair, Library Reserve, and Administration Reserve accounts as stated above for the total amount of \$25,750.00.
