

5. Festival Parking:

Food Court Vendors may park East of I Care Pharmacy at the open lot adjacent to the Hillside IGA parking lot. (Vendor Parking Signs will be posted on lots).

6. Set Up:

Vendors must set up and take down their own space. Vendors are not allowed to nail, screw or attach anything to columns, trees, doors, etc.

7. Responsibility and Security:

Vendors must firmly cover their display in case of wind or rain as the festival takes place "rain or shine." By acceptance of this agreement, the exhibitor expressly releases the Maine Potato Blossom Festival™ and its representatives from all liabilities for any damages, injury or loss to any person or goods from any cause.

8. Vendor Fees and Payments:

Vendors can send the application and nonreturnable **\$25 deposit** prior to **May 1, 2019** to reserve their space. Payment must be received in full before **July 1, 2019**. No refunds will be given to vendors who are unable to attend, or due to inclement weather or any other unforeseen circumstance.

Payment by check can be made payable to "**Town of Fort Fairfield.**" Please include current phone number on all checks.

All payments made with a credit/debit card will incur a 2.5% State of Maine Payport Fee or a minimum fee of \$1 if the total amount due is under \$40.

All permits and licenses must be displayed in your booth during the festival. Vendors are responsible for reporting sales tax directly to the State of Maine.
- All food booths will be inspected by a State of Maine Health Inspector.
- No pets are allowed in the Food Court.
- All vendor items are subject to review by the Maine Potato Blossom Festival™ Director and Festival Vendor Chair.
- No items bearing the words "Maine Potato Blossom Festival™" may be sold on the grounds without prior permission of the Festival Director.
- The Festival Director has the right to remove anyone not complying with the rules.
